6. Why did Jesus name Paul as his *"chosen instrument to take my message to the gentiles, and to kings, as well as to the people of Israel?"*
7. What would it mean to you to resemble Jesus so much that you looked like his brother or sister?
8. Have you ever "seen Jesus" in a person? In what way?
9. Even though it might not be through a light and voice from heaven, in what ways does Jesus get our attention today?
