OVERVIEW

From denying Jesus to proclaiming him Lord on Pentecost

"So let everyone in Israel know for certain that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, to be both Lord and Messiah!" Acts 2:36

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Tim mentioned that Jesus gave Simon the nickname, Peter, which means "the rock".
 - a. Has anyone ever given you a nickname? How did it come about?
 - b. Why do you think Jesus gave nicknames?
- 2. Read Acts 2:1-16; 32-41. What details stand out to you from this account and from what Tim added?
- 3. Why were the believers speaking in other languages?
- 4. What is significant about the timing of this event (the coming of the Holy Spirit/Peter's preaching)?
- 5. Peter transitioned from denying Jesus to proclaiming him Lord and starting the church. How does this transition compare to the start of the Grace Care Center?
- 6. What has the Care Center meant to you over the years?
- 7. Have you ever been put in a position where you could deny Jesus or proclaim Him Lord? How did you handle this?
- 8. Tell about a time when the Holy Spirit has filled you with power or boldness.
