

## **Summer Internship Program Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

Q. Are any of the Internship Programs paid?

A. Yes, all Summer Internships are paid.

Q. How much are interns paid?

A. Summer Interns receive a \$3,300 over the course of the Summer.

Q. Do I have to fundraise as part of the Summer Internship Program?

A. No. We believe the individuals participating in the Summer Internship Program shouldn't raise their program costs as part of the experience of since they are making a short-term commitment to ministry work. However, since Grace covers the cost of the Summer Internship Program, we can only hire up to 10 Summer Interns.

Q. Is there a part-time Summer Internship?

A. We do not offer part-time internships in the Summer.

Q. Can I do my internship during a different season than listed on the website?

A. Because of the development portion of the internship as well as the practicum opportunities, the internship needs to be in the same season for all. That season is during the Summer period of the year.

Q. Do I get paid for the 15 hours per week spent in Intern Development?

A. Yes.

Q. Can I use the Summer Internship Program for academic credit?

A. Yes. We've done this in the past and will work with students, and their universities, so they can receive academic credit for participating in the program.

Q. Does Grace Church provide housing for Summer Interns?

A. Yes. We provide housing for those participating in the program if needed.

Q. Will I need my own car?

A. Yes. There isn't public transportation in Hamilton County and you will need a means of transporting yourself to and from Summer Internship Program related activities and events.

Q. How will I know which ministry areas of Grace will have Summer Interns?

A. We will have knowledge of all ministry areas that would like to have interns and will begin to pair interns as part of the process after that date. Please note there is a question regarding desired ministry areas on the online application.
